We serve a God who is never caught off guard.


The barn burned down sometime before 7 am. Staff was supposed to arrive in less than three hours for training. Camps were starting four days after that. Was it even possible at this point?


INCOME & EXPENDITURES

NUEYO · CHALK TALK · WAR ROOM

NUEYO (Never UnderEstimate Your Opponent) groups provide a time for volunteers (middle school, high school or adult) to pour into middle/elementary school-aged children all year. NUEYO provides a place of belonging, a time of sharpening in Scripture and encouragement through prayer and accountability. Providing spiritual training, NUEYO increases youth and leaders ability to see the unseen. The 2021-2022 academic year Still Water hosted 8 groups in the Hill Country, 2 in Coastal Bend, 1 in Houston, and 1 in San Antonio. This fall, we have kicked off with 16 groups in Boerne.

Some of our young adult staff meet weekly or bi-weekly to dive into the Word together and hold one another accountable in their faith. A community outside of camp is vital to spiritual growth and our staff gets the extraordinary opportunity to soak up moments with one another this coming year!
