## Job Description

### QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- **Background / Experience in the sport you will be coaching.**
- **Previous Coaching Experience.**
- **Positive Christlike role model.**
  - communicating the importance of competition while maintaining an eternal perspective and modeling Christlike sportsmanship. (Colossians 3:23, I Corinthians 9:24:27)
- **Servant Leader & Team player.**

### CHAIN OF COMMUNICATION

- **Report to Camp Director.**
- **Collaborate with Assistant Coach(es).**
- **Communicate well with all campers and staff.**

### PRE-CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Complete and turn in Youth Protection Training and W9 forms to Hospitality Director before the first week of camp you are working.**
- **If possible be present at necessary staff trainings & conference calls.**
- **Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally, and physically.**
- **Contact all assistant coaches to coordinate sport goals and plan for the week.**
- **Make sure you have all the equipment you need in the sporting sheds.**
- **Communicate with Camp Director regarding equipment needs.**
- **Prepare each SWISS workout with a detailed schedule.**
  - **Make sure to have plans for each level of camper (Ages 8-15)**
- **Familiarize yourself with property layout and where your sport will take place.**

# CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Be present at staff devotionals in the morning.**
- **Have a total of 4 sport sessions planned with adaptation for multiple levels of learners.**
- **Ensure excellent sport specific training for each camper in your assigned sport.**
- **Be present and ready to assist with supervising campers during War Room.**
- **Be present and ready to assist with SWAT.**
- **Collaborate with TLC regarding awards. (MVP, I Am Third, Etc.)**

# POST-CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Gather and pack up all sports equipment**
- **Help with camp clean-up.**
- **Complete Staff Evaluation.**
