## QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- **Must be able to play an instrument and sing.**
- **Experience with leading worship (able to send recording to Still Water for review)**
- **Responsible, Reliable, Organized and Detailed**
- **Understanding & Believe in the Gospel**
- **Lead the entire camp in praising the Lord through song. (Psalm 100)**
- **Being fluid by going with the flow of a camp schedule.**
- **Having worship slides prepared prior to coming out to camp.**

## CHAIN OF COMMUNICATION

- **Report to the Program Director**
- **Collaborate with Speaker and Program**
- **Communication well with all of camp staff and campers.**

## PRE-CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Intend to be at training week and be apart of conference calls when needed**
- **Complete and turn in Youth Protection Training and W9 Form to Hospitality Director before the first week of camp you will be working.**
- **Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally, and physically prior to coming out to camp.**
- **Provide song list to DOC/CD and Program at least a week prior to camp.**
- **Have at least 1 song with motions and high energy "Ice Breaker Songs"**
- **Provide or communicate to DOC/CD all musical needs for the week**
- **Set-up all equipment and preform sound check for camp.**
- **Familiarize yourself with schedule to understand when, where, and what you will need to be doing at what time.**

# CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Be present at morning staff devotionals**
- **Meet with Program and Speaker daily to plan the flow of chalk talk.**
- **Have editing ability for slides if changes need to happen**
- **Be present at as many activities as possible -- Be a part of camp!**
- **Meet in DUB for sound check before each Chalk Talk**
